Entry is open to UK residents aged four and above. The winners may be asked to provide proof of identity and age.

There are four age categories for the competition, these are;

4-8

9-13

14-17

18+

Parents, carers and legal guardians can submit on behalf of their child.

Pictures taken on any smartphone, tablet or camera are eligible.

No purchase is necessary for participation in this competition.

Up to six entries per person are permitted.

Entrants must comply with the rules of their chosen social media platform, if posting online.

The competition begins at 9am on Thursday 1st July 2021 and runs until 23:59 on Tuesday 31st August 2021. Entries must be submitted and received no later than this date to be eligible for the competition judging. All competition entries after 23:59 on Tuesday 31st August 2021 will not be considered. The Promoter will not accept responsibility for delayed entries, regardless of cause. Proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt.

All those on the shortlist will be contacted by email. The organisers cannot be held responsible for emails that do not arrive.
