Terms and Conditions

Entry is open to UK residents aged over four. The winners may need to be able to provide proof of identity and age.

Email up to six photographs to summersnaps@nickieaiken.org.uk along with your name, address and age. You can also tag **@TwoCitiesNickie** on Facebook, Instagram or Twitter along with **#TwoCitiesSummer** or **#TwoCitiesSummerSnaps**

There are four age categories and one public vote category for the competition, these are;

4-8

9-13

14-17

18+

Public vote

Post your photos onto *Facebook, Instagram or Twitter*, tag **@TwoCitiesNickie** and use the caption **#TwoCitiesSummer** or **#TwoCitiesSummerSnaps**. The photographer with the most likes, shares and retweets will win the public vote category.

Parents, carers and legal guardians can submit on behalf of their children.

Pictures taken on any smartphone, tablet or camera are eligible.

No purchase is necessary for participation in this competition.

Up to six entries per person are permitted.

Entrants must comply with the rules of their chosen social media platforms, if posting online.

The competition begins at 9am on Monday 27 June 2022 and runs until 23:59 on Sunday 4 September 2022. Entries must be submitted and received no later than 23:59 on Sunday 4 September 2022 to be eligible for the competition judging. All competition entries after 23:59 on Sunday 4 September 2022 will not be considered. The Promoter will not accept responsibility for delayed entries, regardless of cause. Proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt.

All those on the shortlist will be contacted.

Awards Ceremony

COVID Restrictions allowing, winners and runners up will be invited to a special awards ceremony in the House of Commons in the Autumn.

By entering the competition, you grant the Promoter a non-exclusive, irrevocable licence to reproduce, enlarge, publish or exhibit, on any media, the images for any purpose directly connected with the competition. This may include, but is not limited to: inclusion in a book of winning and commended

images; display at exhibitions; display on a web browser for judging purposes; on the Promoters website and on the websites of sponsors and supporters; on social media used by the Promoter, its sponsors and supporters; for use in releases to be distributed to national, regional & specialist press and other media giving information about or promoting the competition.
